

- EASA licenses are valid in all European Union member states (and Switzerland and Norway) and very easy to convert to any other license type.



Aviation English: ICAO & IR English


ICAO Aviation English is the international language of civil aviation. Passing the language proficiency check is also one of the necessary steps during the PPL(A) training to start flying as Pilot in Command under supervision of a flight instructor. The goal of IR(A) Aviation English course is to improve the Aviation phraseology skills and gain necessary vocabulary for conducting the communication during the IFR flights.

ICAO English

Currently, each pilot flying internationally must have a minimum level 4 of ICAO English language proficiency check on their license.

How long is the ICAO English language proficiency valid?



Conversation and description (from aviation industry)

Listening to aviation communication – pilot must be able to answer the examiner's questions

Reading and understanding of an article from manual, aviation regulation or aviation publication.

What does the ICAO English language proficiency check consist of?

Duration of the check is approximately 30 minutes and the evaluation is done on the spot.

How much does ICAO English exam cost?

The price of the ICAO language proficiency check is 112 EUR.

IR(A) Aviation English

Prior to the practical examination (Skill Test) for the Instrument Rating IR(A), you have to pass a theoretical examination in IR Aviation English (according to the FCL. 055 Language proficiency). We also offer an IR English course to help you prepare for the exam.

The IR English course consists of:

- Grammar
- General English and communication
- · Abbreviations, phraseology
- Devices and navigation
- Meteorology
- Descriptions (planning)
- Flight traffic control, manuals
- Final exam

What are the objectives of the IR(A) Aviation English course?

The goal is to improve the Aviation phraseology skills and gain necessary vocabulary for conducting the communication during the IFR flights. They will develop practical habits for using standard phraseology and the ability to understand broadcasts in the cockpit environment.



How much does the IR Aviation English course cost?

The course price is 400 EUR.

What does the Instrument Rating - IR(A) Aviation English proficiency check consist of?

The IR Aviation English proficiency check consists of two parts:

- the written part
- oral part



Both take place on the same day, one after the other. Written test takes 60 minutes and contains radiotelephony phraseology, acronyms, communication and general English knowledge test (reading and understanding). Students that pass the test with over 80% success rate, then proceed to the second part: the oral one, that takes approximately 30 minutes. During the exam, you discuss the results of the written test followed by an interview and simulation of IFR flight communication.

Upon the end of the exam, you will receive a certificate, based on which the CAA can add the qualification to your license.
